## **CHARGE**

Photographs play a vital role in how we communicate as architects, designers and artists. They capture "place" during a single moment in time, strong enough to elicit emotion, conjure memories and stir imagination.

In its fourth year, the AIA Birmingham EP Photography Competition is the biggest annual event for AIA Birmingham's Emerging Professionals, a group made up of architects and interns under age 35. intended to celebrate and highlight exceptional photography within the design profession and greater Birmingham area. Each entry must have an architectural theme and/or must contain some element of the main-made environment.

#### SUBJECT MATTER AND FORMAT

The entry is to be of a human-made environment, but the term 'architectural' is applied loosely and is open to interpretation of the entrant. Building exteriors, cityscapes, interiors, and designed landscapes are all appropriate. Photographs will be judged on subject matter, technical mastery, conveyance of emotion, and overall form and beauty. The photos may be black and white or color, and special consideration will be given to entries featuring the architecture of Birmingham, AL. Prints are to be 11x14 inches, and at a minimum mounted onto foam core with a 2-inch white matte; framed entries are encouraged but not required for consideration.
